Paediatric First Aid (level 3) is designed for those in the workplace working to become a Paediatric First Aider. This is suitable for employees with a responsibility for the welfare of infants and children. First aid is the responsibility of everyone involved in the working environment. Topics within this course are regarded by the Early Years Foundation Stage as being important to maintaining good practice in the safe, prompt and effective treatment of injuries and ill health of infants and children who are under the care of trained personnel.

This qualification meets the requirements for Paediatric First Aid outlined in the Early Years Foundation Stage 2014.

Participants will be able to:

- Understand the roles & responsibilities of a paediatric first aider, assess an emergency situation safely & maintain adequate record keeping
- Provide first aid for in a range of situations including, minor injuries, injuries to the eyes, ears and nose, burn & scalds, bites, stings, poisoning, breathing difficulties, shock, bleeding and unresponsive infants & children
